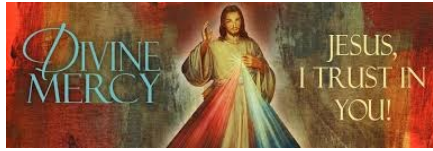

**CAFOD** (St Helen's) *pray-fast-give* 

CAFOD has been working through partners in East Africa to build up resilience against natural threats.

In the past year in Zimbabwe 1,403 people have been taught to adapt farming methods to a changing climate, 17 sites have been identified for new community vegetable gardens, 233 fruit trees have been planted in schools and 27 nurses and community health workers have been trained to spot and treat malnutrition.

So, far 4,293 people have benefited from these programmes in Zimbabwe whilst over a quarter of a million people in Zimbabwe, Zambia and Eritrea are scheduled to benefit from funding already delegated to the next two years.
