During the industrial revolution in Britain many thousands of people left the poverty of rural life to seek better for themselves and their families in the growing cities. My own ancestors include Cornishmen, Lancashire miners, a Danish seaman, a German chair maker and, of course, lots of Irishmen and women.

Whilst cities in the developing world are less cosmopolitan, as they grow they remain a magnet for those living tenuous lives on the land. Lima is the second biggest desert city in the world and it has many thousands of formerly rural people living in "informal" developments around the city's boundaries. Often ignored by the city, these people benefit from aid from CAFOD as they seek to build the frameworks of support they are denied by the authorities.
